





In the twentieth century, the Hudson River Valley became a refuge for many artists who sought solitude and space. Designers and sculptors were drawn to the Valley, who then in turn, attracted collectors of large-scale sculpture. We will consider this site, and many of the works within it.

Nov 13 Displaying Art in the Hudson River Valley

In 1864, Vassar College in Poughkeepsie established the first art gallery in an American university, integrating the display of art and art education as a central tenet of their educational plan. We will discuss the centrality of art exhibitions and its continuation into the 21st Century with the opening of Dia Beacon in 2003, a massive contemporary art space.

Bowers' Books for Kids: Storytime in the Galleries




